ORDER WITH CONFIDENCE:

OUR GUARANTEE If you are not happy with your plants on arrival, please contact us & explain your concerns. Where agreed, we will either replace the plants, credit your account, or refund your money. If your plants look fine on arrival & you follow our growing instructions, but they do not perform according to reasonable expectations within 12 months, please contact us by phone & we will offer advice. Where agreed, we will replace the plants.

WHERE TO PLANT The ideal location is in a sunny, well drained position where they will receive at least 6 hours of sunlight (or more in Tas, Vic, SA & Sthn WA). Make sure there will be no competition from roots of trees or other vigorous plants (such as agapanthus). Protection from the hot afternoon sun is advised in areas that experience very high temperatures in summer.

SOIL PREPARATION Daylilies like a free-draining soil which has old manures or compost added to it, & plenty of mulch. Hay, pine bark, or cane trash are suitable mulches. Mushroom compost is NOT recommended. Avoid planting your daylilies in parts of your garden where other plants have not grown well—particularly gerberas, chrysanthemums, roses etc.

HOW TO PLANT A daylily is NOT a bulb & should not be treated like one. Plant your daylilies so that the stump of the foliage is at the soil surface, & sprinkle fine soil over the roots. The crown should be about an inch below the surface. Press it down firmly & water it in well to remove any air pockets. Do not over-water at this time - just once a week is sufficient. Plant the large flowered varieties at least 60 cm apart & the small-flowered at least 40 cm apart. If planting them in pots for a sunny patio, use pots at least 25cm to 30cm diameter & a top quality potting mix that is free-draining. Daylilies do NOT like wet feet!

FERTILISING About a week after planting, apply a cupful of a well-balanced organic fertiliser to the soil surface, no closer than 15cm (6") from the plant & then apply 10 cm (4") of mulch. A popular organic fertiliser available nationwide is Dynamic Lifter Plus, or similar products like Organic Extra or Organic Life can be applied every three months. A handful of lime per square metre per year is very beneficial. If you can find a source of worm castings in your area, these are also excellent.
